### Fall 2023 Programming Updates

#### Weekly Groups and School Groups Resume

This fall, Ele's Place – Ann Arbor resumed our weekly peer support groups for grieving children and teens ages 3-18 and their adults. Evening support programs help children and teens understand that they are not alone in their grief after a person dies, providing an opportunity to connect with others in an emotionally safe environment that supports the sharing of feelings, thoughts and experiences. As always, our peer support groups are 100% free of charge for as long as a family needs them.

Ele's Place – Ann Arbor staff also continue to support our school partners and their students through Ele's Group, our school-based peer grief support groups, as well as through consultations with school staff members.



# Families Make Candles to Honor Their Person at Remembrance Family Night

This November, we invited enrolled families to participate in a Remembrance Family Night. During these evenings, families stay together and have the opportunity to participate in a planned activity as a unit. Participating families created a candle in remembrance of their person, with the intention of honoring the lives of those who died and providing a space for remembrance .
