Having recently celebrated my first anniversary as the Director of Ele's Place West Michigan, I am grateful to be able to share with you the impact that our organization had on the West Michigan community in 2019. We could not do this work without YOU and those committed to ensuring that no child grieves alone. Currently, one in 13 Michigan children will experience the death of a parent or sibling prior to their 18th birthday. This does not include those children for whom someone else close to them, like a grandparent, teacher or friend will die. As we consider this sobering data, it is more apparent than ever that the support Ele's Place West Michigan provides at no charge to grieving children, teens and their families is imperative to the mental health and wellbeing of our community.

Due to your generosity and support, we accomplished the following 2019 at Ele's Place West Michigan:

- ♥ Served 345 grieving children and teens.
- ♥ Served 184 students in our school-based program, Ele's Group.
- ♥ Provided 455 clinical consultations to grieving families and concerned community members.
- ♥ Provided educational presentations about children's grief to 137 members of the community.
- ♥ Served families across West Michigan including those from Kent, Ottawa, Allegan, Newaygo, Ionia, Kalamazoo and Barry Counties, with 69% of our participants being Kent County residents.

While this report is intended to highlight 2019, I would be remiss not to address how our organization is faring throughout the COVID-19 pandemic and its effects on our community, the state and the world. As we know, individuals continue to experience the death of those close to them, including the children of our community. We stand committed to serving these needs in new and innovative ways to ensure the safety of our families, volunteers, and staff, including virtual peer support groups for children and teens and a virtual enrollment process for new families. We continue to provide support to families who are grieving through phone consultations and by providing virtual activities through our social media channels and emails for all of those in our community who may be grieving during this unusual time where we are separated and distanced from our normal support channels.

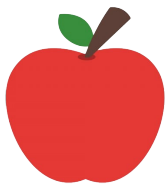

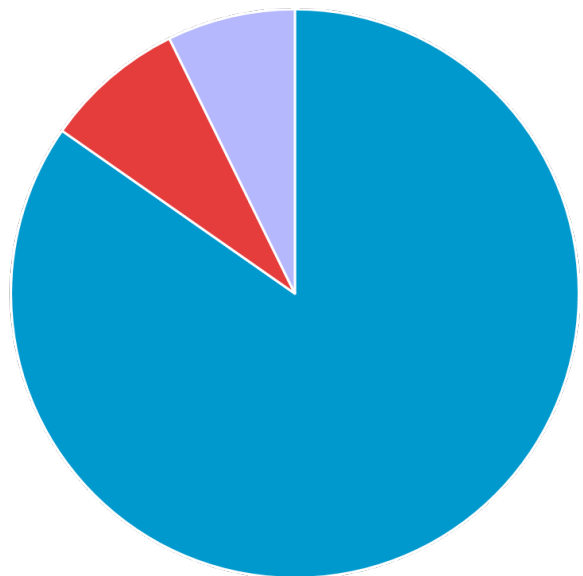
