Dear Friends.

Thank you so much for your ongoing support of the mission of Ele's Place and our local Greater Flint and Genesee County chapter. In Michigan, 1 in 13 children will experience the loss of a parent or sibling before their 18th birthday. That number is significantly higher if you consider the loss of a grandparent or other important person in their lives. For 30 years, Ele's Place has been committed to ensuring that no child in Michigan grieves alone.

2020 was a year like no other. We found ourselves in a global pandemic. As an organization whose focus is supporting children, teens, and their families who are grieving the death of someone significant in their life, we faced major challenges in continuing our support. As the world shut down and it was no longer safe to conduct face-to-face supportive services, and all fundraising events were canceled. Our staff was swift to respond, developing creative and helpful ways to continue to support our current Ele's Place families as well as hundreds more who were experiencing the death of a family member due to Covid-19.

Despite how challenging this past year has been, Ele's Place of Greater Flint and Genesee County has provided:

In addition, for the third year in a row, Ele's Place has been awarded the Platinum Seal of Transparency from GuideStar. Not only does a Platinum Seal take into account what important information the non-profit has publicly shared in regards to its goals, strategies, and vision—it recognizes the metrics that show progress made toward achieving its mission. Only approximately 5% of US nonprofits achieve any of the four GuideStar Seal rankings, Platinum, Gold, Silver, or Bronze. Of this 5% just 15% are awarded a Platinum Seal. This level of ranking puts Ele's Place in the company of such respected organizations as the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation.

SUPPORT GROUPS - 126 (87 CHILDREN AND 39 ADULTS)

Family based programming, onsite at our facilities (conducted via Zoom due to the COVID-19 pandemic.) Provides peer support to kids 3-18 and an optional support group for their caregiver.



SCHOOL GROUPS - 58 STUDENTS IN 9 GROUPS


Peer support groups within the school setting, primarily in Middle School and HS.



CLINICAL CONSULTATION- 173 PEOPLE

Phone, virtual or in-person one-to-one grief support, conducted by a licensed Ele's Place staff person. Includes the initial intake for families to coordinate attending onsite programs.

Virtual Family Activity "Care Tags"





