



Peer Grief Support – Program Updates



Summer Wrap-Up & Fall 2021 Programs

We ended our summer grief support programs at the end of July with virtual bubble releases. Families gathered together via Zoom for this special event, and TOGETHER they blew bubbles into the air and took time to reflect on their wishes or messages to their people who died. While the person who died may not actually receive the bubbles sent to them, this event provides space for everyone to remember their person, and think about what they wish they could say to them.

At this time, it is our intention to return to in-person evening peer grief support groups in the fall! We look forward to cautiously and safely welcoming our families, volunteers and staff back into our Home for Healing Hearts. This fall, our

evening support groups will meet two weeks per month and serve grieving children and teens ages 3-18, and their adults, at no cost to the family. Our peer support group program offers children and teens the opportunity to connect with others that have experienced similar losses. Our groups are designed to provide an emotionally safe environment which encourages trust and sharing. Our children's groups are facilitated by trained volunteers and overseen by licensed Clinical Program Staff. Adult groups for the primary parent/guardians are led by licensed Clinicians.

In addition, as more schools return to onsite schooling, our school-based staff is looking forward to supporting our school partners and their students. We hope to return to onsite school peer grief support groups (Ele's Group), and welcome new partners during the 2021-

2022 school year.
