Peer Grief Support - Program Updates



Spring 2023 Programming

As the school year wrapped up, so did Ele's Place Ann Arbor's weekly peer support groups, offered Monday through Thursday evenings for grieving children and teens ages 3-18, and their adults. Evening support programs help children and teens understand that they are not alone in their grief and provide an opportunity to connect with others who have experienced the death of a person in an emotionally safe environment that supports the sharing of feelings, thoughts and experiences. Please note, Ele's Place Ann Arbor offers alternative programming during the summer months and Clinical Program Staff remain available to support families through consultation.

Peer support groups are divided by age/grade: Preschool/Kindergarten, Early Elementary, Upper Elementary, Middle School and High School. Trained volunteers facilitate the children and teen groups with oversight by Ele's Place Ann Arbor Program Staff. Support groups for the parents/guardians of enrolled children and teens are also available. Licensed mental health clinicians facilitate the adult groups.

As a finale to the onsite program year in May, families gathered the last week of programming for our annual Bubble Release. These evenings provide an opportunity for families to participate in an activity together where they can reflect on wishes or messages they have for the people who have died.

Summer 2023 Programming

At Ele's Place Ann Arbor, we know grief does not take a summer break. In June, we hosted the first of three monthly Family Nights to be held during the 2023 summer session. Summer family nights are offered to enrolled families, as well as families who have completed an intake and are pending group placement. Please note, Ele's Place Ann Arbor welcomes new families to enroll for Fall 2023 programming any time throughout the summer.

These Family Nights are designed to provide a safe space to come together and to support a family in exploring their grief together as a family unit, through guided activities, games and discussions. This open and flexible engagement opportunity aims to support families in communicating about the death of their person(s) and their grief.

"Search & Share" Activity

At the June Family Night, families engaged in an activity called "Search & Share." This activity allows each individual family member to "search" through seemingly random objects or figures that may resonate with them – perhaps a bandaid reminds them of their hurt feelings, or a camera reminds them of a photo they took with the person who died. Family members then "share" their reasoning for picking that item and add it to a shared family poster. This activity promotes sharing of feelings, memories and experiences among family members. •



School-Based Programs

We are thrilled we provided nine Ele's Group school-based sessions during the spring of 2023! The Ele's Place Ann Arbor school-based staff and volunteer facilitators support our school partners and their students through Ele's Group, our school peer grief support groups, as well as through consultations with school staff members. Working in partnership with school clinical staff to provide 8-week peer support groups in many area middle and high schools, we strive to remove barriers and meet grieving students where they are – at school!

Program Volunteer Appreciation

April was Volunteer Appreciation Month, and we used this opportunity to pamper our Program Volunteers with self-care during a Wellness Event! We were honored to offer them an evening filled with wellness and restoration, including a sound bath experience, yoga sessions and several creative and healing activities. These generous people serve as Support Group Facilitators, Activity Room Volunteers, Kitchen Volunteers & Therapy Dog Handlers during our peer grief support programs. We appreciate the warmth, compassion and dedication our volunteers express when they support
