All applicants must attend a pre-training interview before starting training.

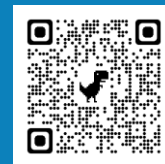
Completion of online modules, two Zoom training sessions and in-person training session are required to become a Volunteer Support Group Facilitator. No previous experience necessary.
